Parent Tip of the Month

After the holidays, it's completely normal for children to need time to settle back into routines. A few simple resets can make mornings smoother and help kids feel more secure:



- Keep mornings predictable (same steps, same order)
- Move bedtime earlier by 10-15 minutes if needed
- Offer small choices ("blue coat or green coat?")
- Expect big feelings—transitions can be tough, even for adults!



Once routines are re-established, confidence grows quickly. Consistency at home and school makes such a difference.

We are so thankful she's part of our Sprouts family!




Featured Book

Expansion Update: Growing to Meet Community Need

Sprouts is growing quickly—and while we're grateful, we're reaching a point where space is a challenge. We're beginning conversations with the new council about purchasing the library building next door once the library relocates.

This could allow:
